



1) Kensington Stables

- Current zoning is C8-2 and lot size is 5,890 square feet
- Declared bankruptcy in February 2017
- New partnership announced in March 2018
- Planning for long-term preservation of the stables



2) 57 Caton Place

- Current zoning is C8-2 and lot size is 23,702 square feet
- Proposal to rezone to R7A, with a C2-4 overlay
 - 107 residential units
 - 9,722 square feet of commercial
- Mandatory inclusionary housing
 - 25% of units for households making
 60% of area median income, or
 \$62,580 for a family of four




3) Calvary Cathedral Church Parking Lot

- Current zoning is C8-2 and lot size is 21,992 square feet
- Sold in April 2017 to JEMB Realty
- Purchased by Sabharwal Properties
- Permits filed in January 2018 for an eight-story CubeSmart

4) International Baptist Church Parking Lot

- Current zoning is C8-2 and lot size is 17,988 square feet
- Parking lot was recently sold to a developer
- No proposal as of yet



5) The Parade Grounds

- GallopNYC
 - Therapeutic horse-backing riding on the Bowling Green
 - Three to four days per week in spring and fall
- Kensington Dog Run
 - Funded via participatory budgeting in spring 2016
 - Construction anticipated to begin in spring 2019
